

The Birth Doula Workshop

The Women's Health and Birth Center Doula Workshop is a unique and exciting training offering guidance and birth experience. The workshop does not include clinical skills which are outside the scope of practice of the doula. The course is designed to help participants become expert labor support providers and gain experience as a doula. It utilizes texts and supplementary literature, videos, and role play to build theoretical knowledge and practical skills. This training meets the workshop hours required for DONA International certification. For those taking the training at the Birth Center, you have the opportunity to get birth experience by being on call for births. What is a Doula?

The doula recognizes birth as a key life experience. She understands the physiology of birth and the emotional needs of a the woman in labor.

The doula assists the woman in preparing for birth and carrying out her plans for her birth.

The doula stays by the side of the laboring woman throughout her labor.

The doula provides emotional support, practical comfort measures, and an objective view point and information to aid in decision making.

The doula acts as a liaison between the laboring woman, her partner, and clinical care providers.

The doula does not replace the woman's partner or clinical providers.

Desired Background for Participants

Participants of the Birth Doula Workshop should have the following knowledge:

- Anatomy of the reproductive system
- Physiology of pregnancy, birth, postpartum, and breastfeeding
- Definitions of medical terms
- Common procedures and testing used during normal birth
- Pain medications, their administrations and effects
- The Cesarean procedure
- Normal newborn appearance
- Basic relaxation techniques, breathing patterns, and other comfort measures for labor
- Benefits of breastfeeding

If you do not have this knowledge of childbirth it is strongly recommended that you take the Intro to Childbirth Education class. This class fulfills the childbirth education requirements for DONA certification. It brings you one more step closer to certification!

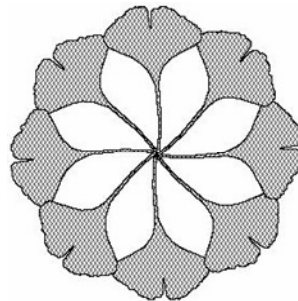
